



YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboards:

2 large squares

Other:

Iron and ironing paper
Scissors and clear tape
Tweezers
Magnets (optional)
Frame (optional)

Instructions

NOTE: The patterns included are a starting point for you to make your own family figures. Change the colors or shapes for hair, skin, clothing, etc to customize the figures as you like. The color lists are for the figures shown.

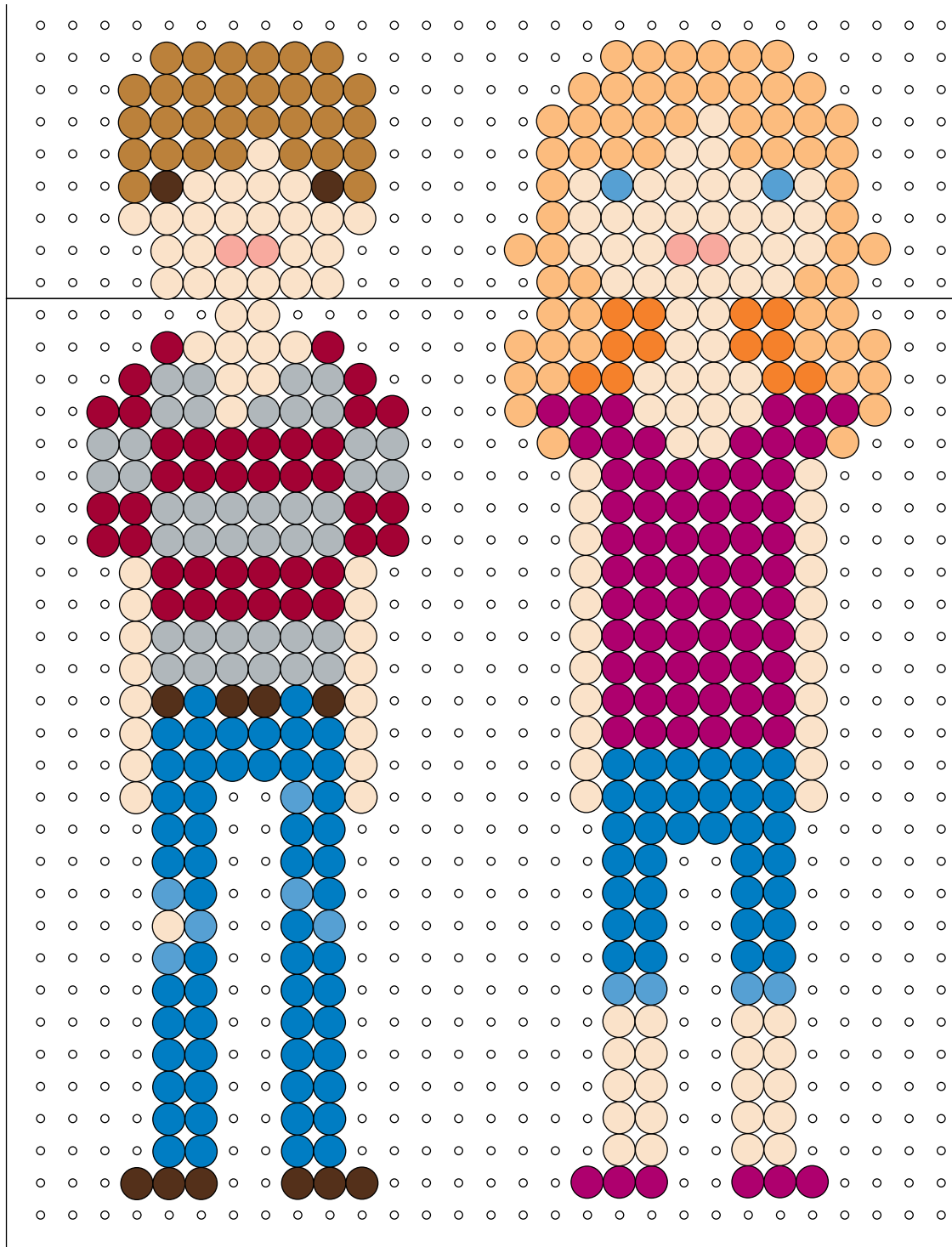
1. Assemble 2 large square pegboards vertically to create your projects (patterns 7 and 8 can be worked individually). Cut out and tape together the pairs of pattern sections. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size pattern underneath them. Place your beads following the pattern.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 7 for further instructions.
3. Assembly: Attach magnets to display your family figures on the fridge, or put them in a frame.

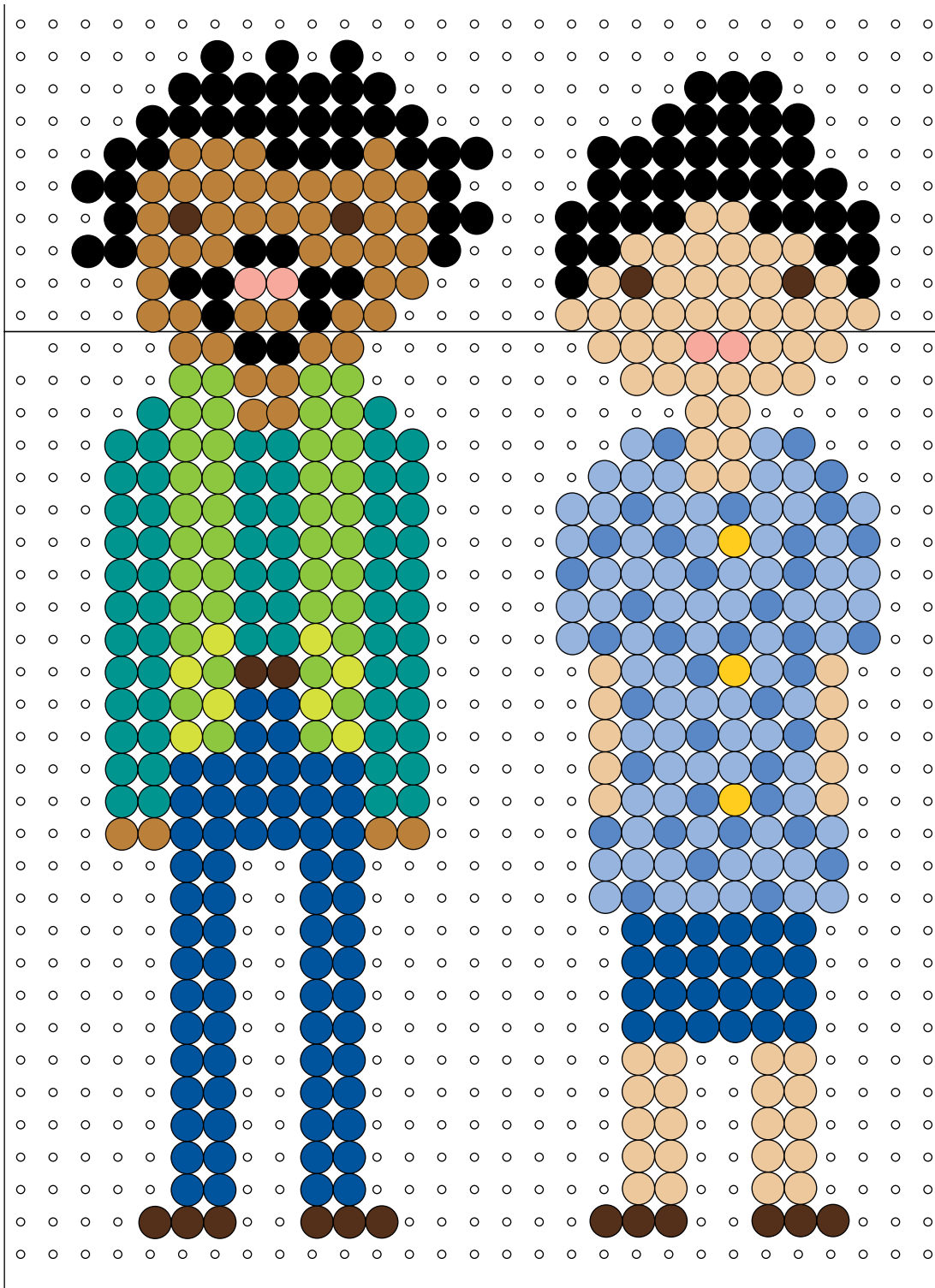

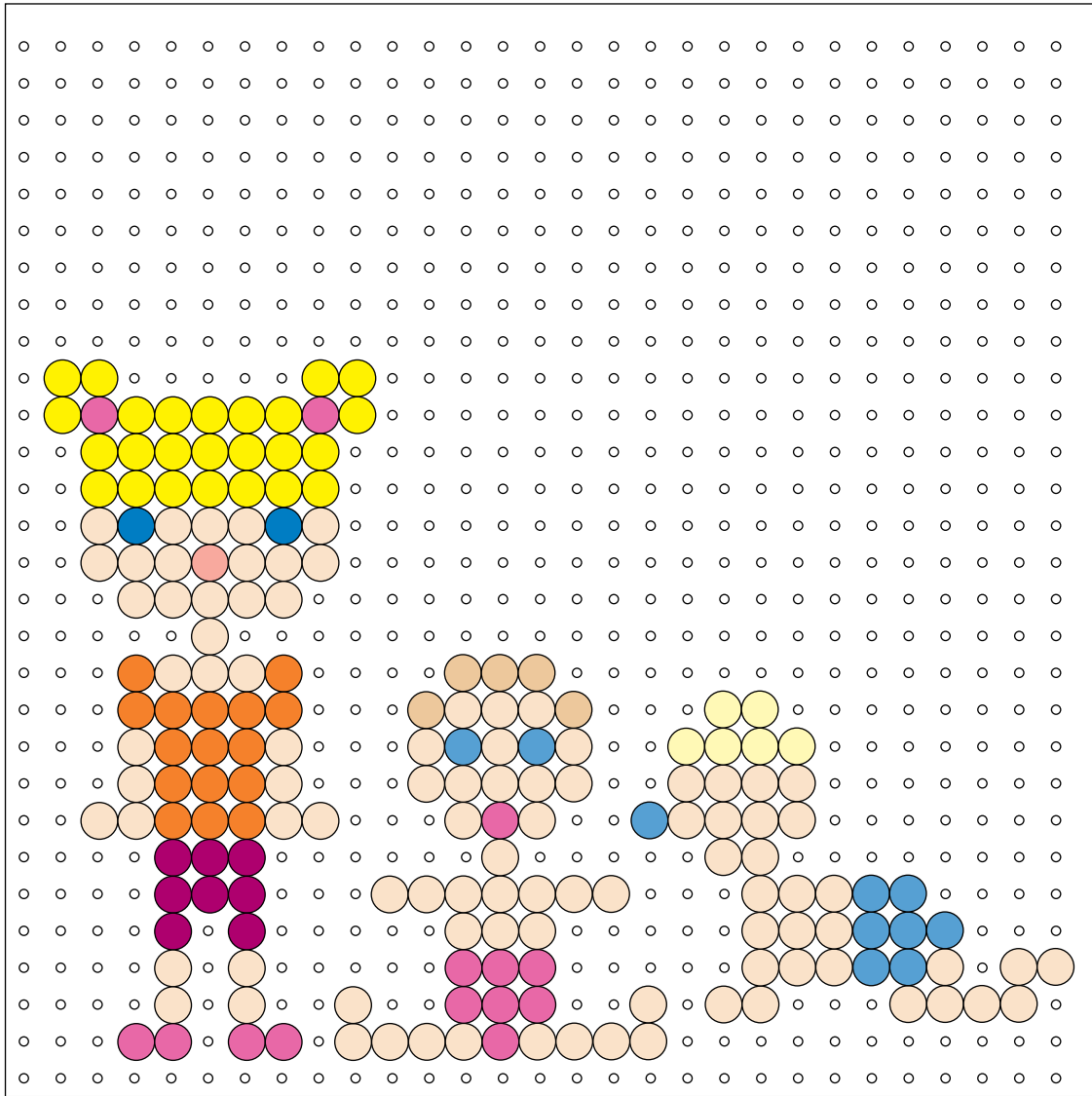

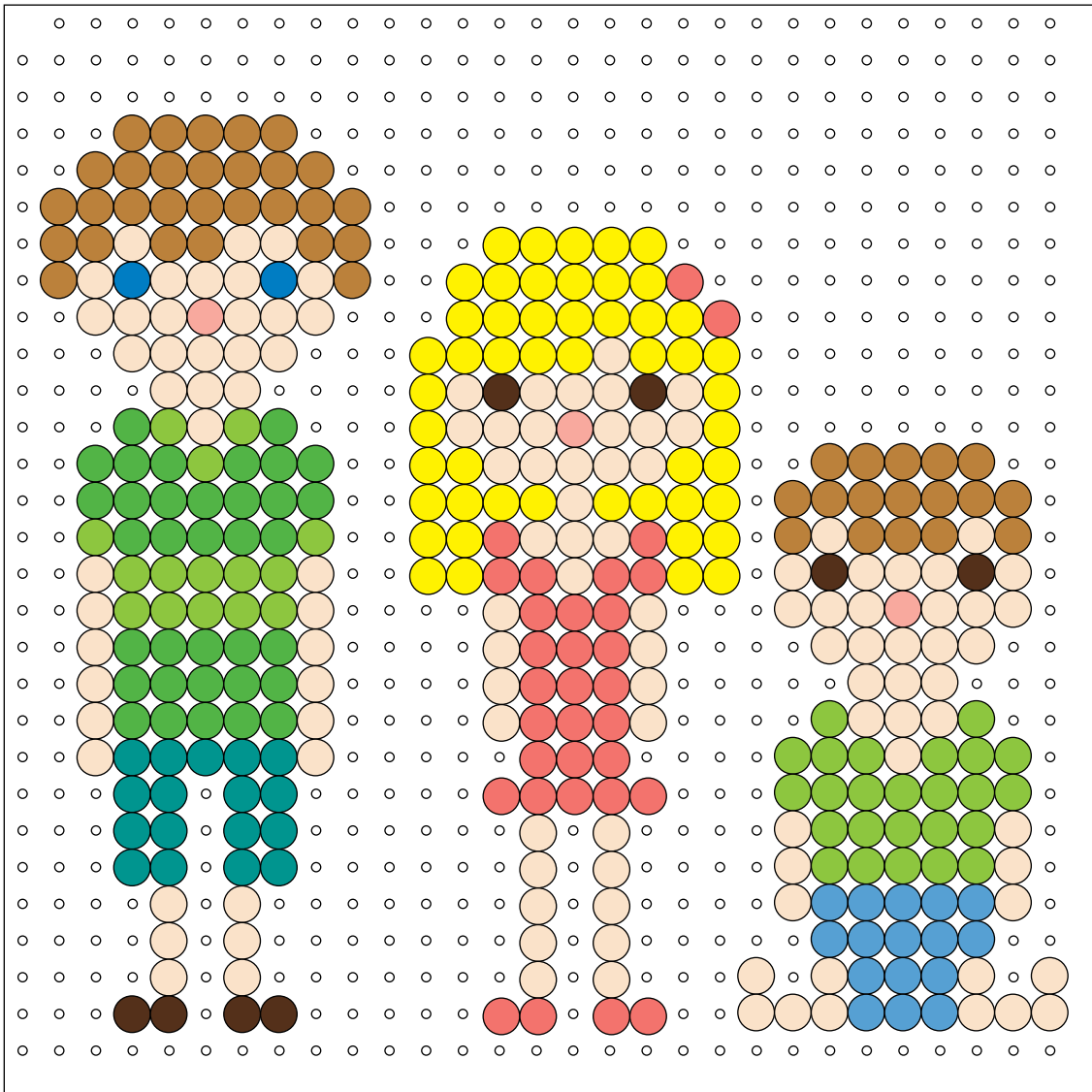

Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely. Your pegboards and ironing paper are reusable.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required.
