## YOU WILL NEED:

## Pegboards:

2 Large squares

#### Other:

Scissors

Clear tape

Gold ribbon: (4) 12" pieces Assorted adhesive gems



- Pastel Lavender 42
- Purple 51
- Raspberry Pearl Stripe 50
- Hot Coral Pearl Stripe 102
- Gold Pearl Stripe 130
- Prickly Pear Pearl Stripe 62

#### **Small Mask Bead Colors:**


- Magenta 61
- Yellow 16
- Dark Green 34
- Plum 36
- Purple 30
- Raspberry Pearl Stripe 13
- Gold Pearl Stripe 6
- Prickly Pear Pearl Stripe 34
- Cucumber Stripe 24
- Starry Nite Stripe 46
- Grape Stripe 28

## **Instructions**

- 1. For the small mask, turn your pegboard to the diagonal. For the large mask, assemble the two pegboards together horizontally. Place your beads on the pegboards as shown. If you are using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it.
- 2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 3 for further instructions. Fuse these masks well on one side only so that they will curve around the face more easily.
- 3. Assembly: see page 4.









Large Mask

Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron FUSE ONE SIDE ONLY



- 1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
- 2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
- 3. Because you want your mask to curve, fuse one side only.


**NOTE:** Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project,

additional heating time may be required. DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make the assembly you do with your project more challenging.


# Fancy Masks **ASSEMBLY**




Tip: Use a 5" piece of thin fishing line to create a loop as shown. This will help thread your ribbon through the beads for the mask ties.




Insert the loop you made above through the designated bead hole from front to back (see placement indicators below). Pass the end of the ribbon through the loop.



Gently pull the ribbon through the bead. Repeat with the adjacent bead to bring the ribbon to the back.



Knot the ribbon to secure it on the back.



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
