Instructions

- Use the large square and small star pegboards for your project. If you're using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it. Place all the beads for the design.
- 2. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. DO NOT OVER-IRON or the centers of the beads will close and make assembly difficult.
- 3. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #2. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

You will also need a length of clear lacing, colored paper clips, magnets, glue, and heavy paper or cardstock to make your banner.





Assembly

- 1. Print the tags at right onto heavy paper or cardstock and cut them out.
- 2. Attach the clear lacing to the bottom of the sailboat through the holes of the beads as shown. Knot at the back to secure.
- 3. Attach each paper clip with a simple overhand knot, spacing them several inches apart.
- 4. Add the tags to the paper clips. Glue magnets to the back of the sailboat and the star, then hang your banner on the fridge for Dad to see on Father's Day!
