



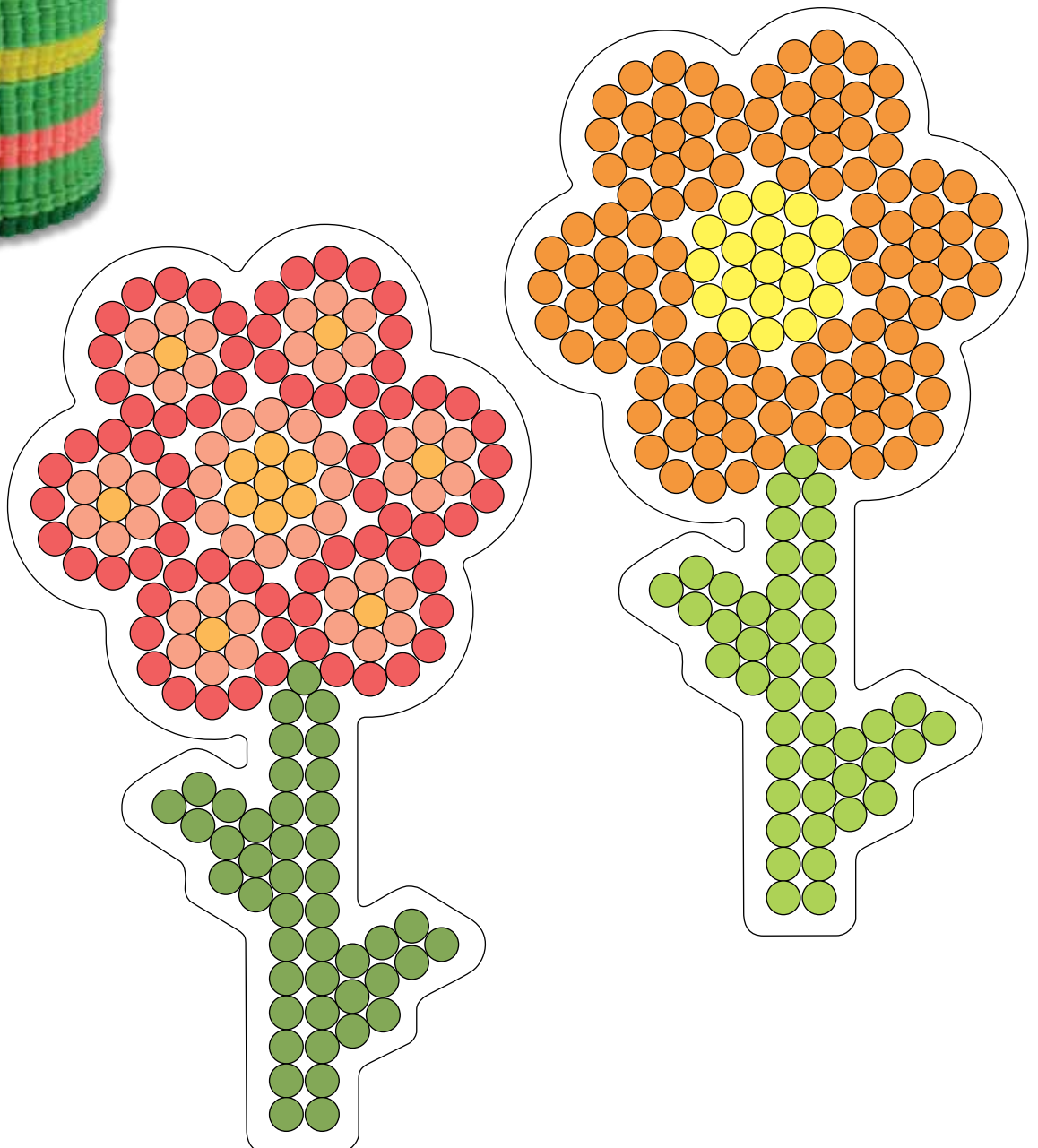
Instructions

1. Use the flower and large circle pegboards for your project. If you're using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it. Place all the beads for the design.
2. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. On a 3-D project such as this, DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make assembly difficult.
3. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #2. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

You will also need craft glue to complete your project.

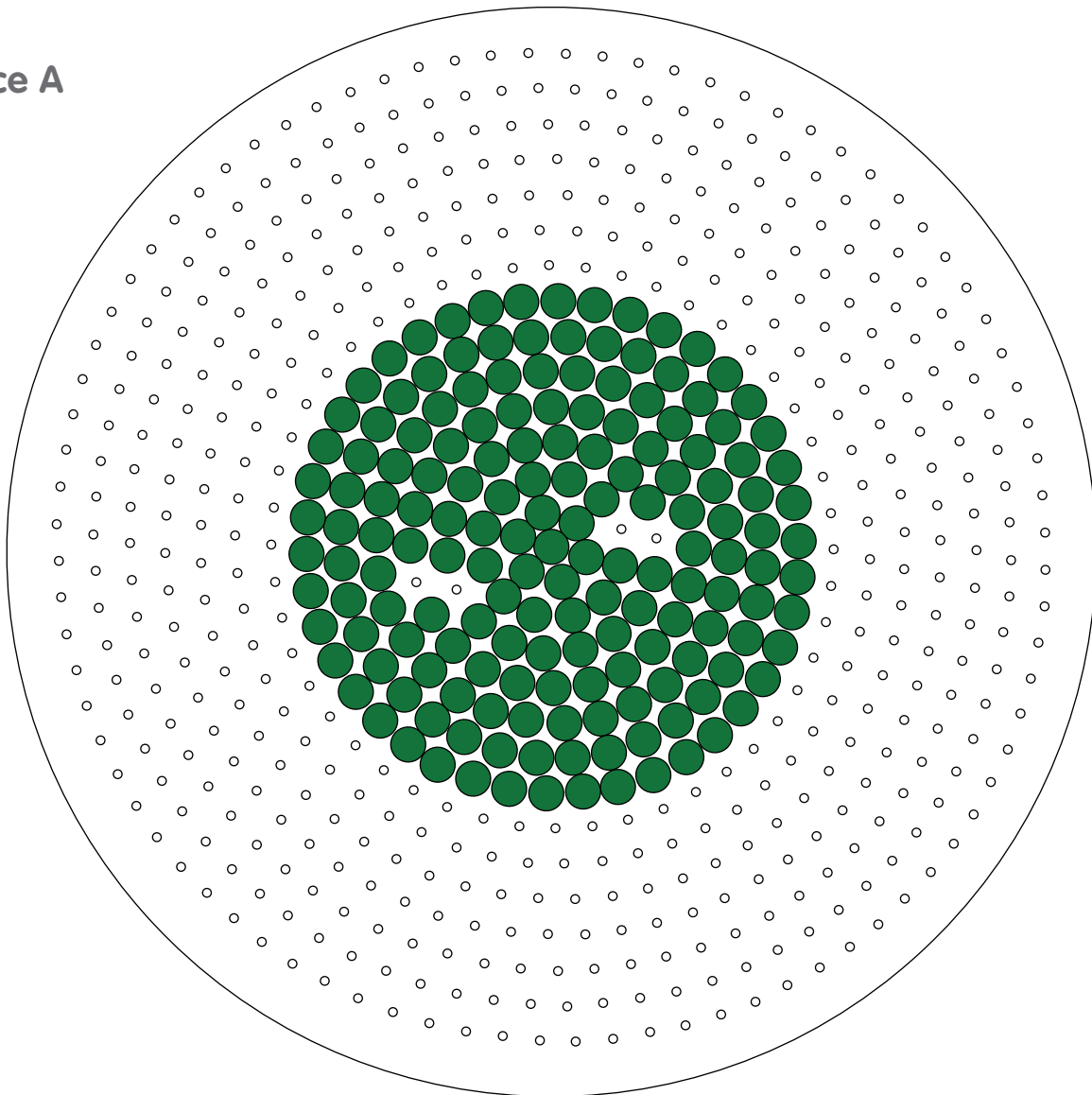

● Dark Green - 165

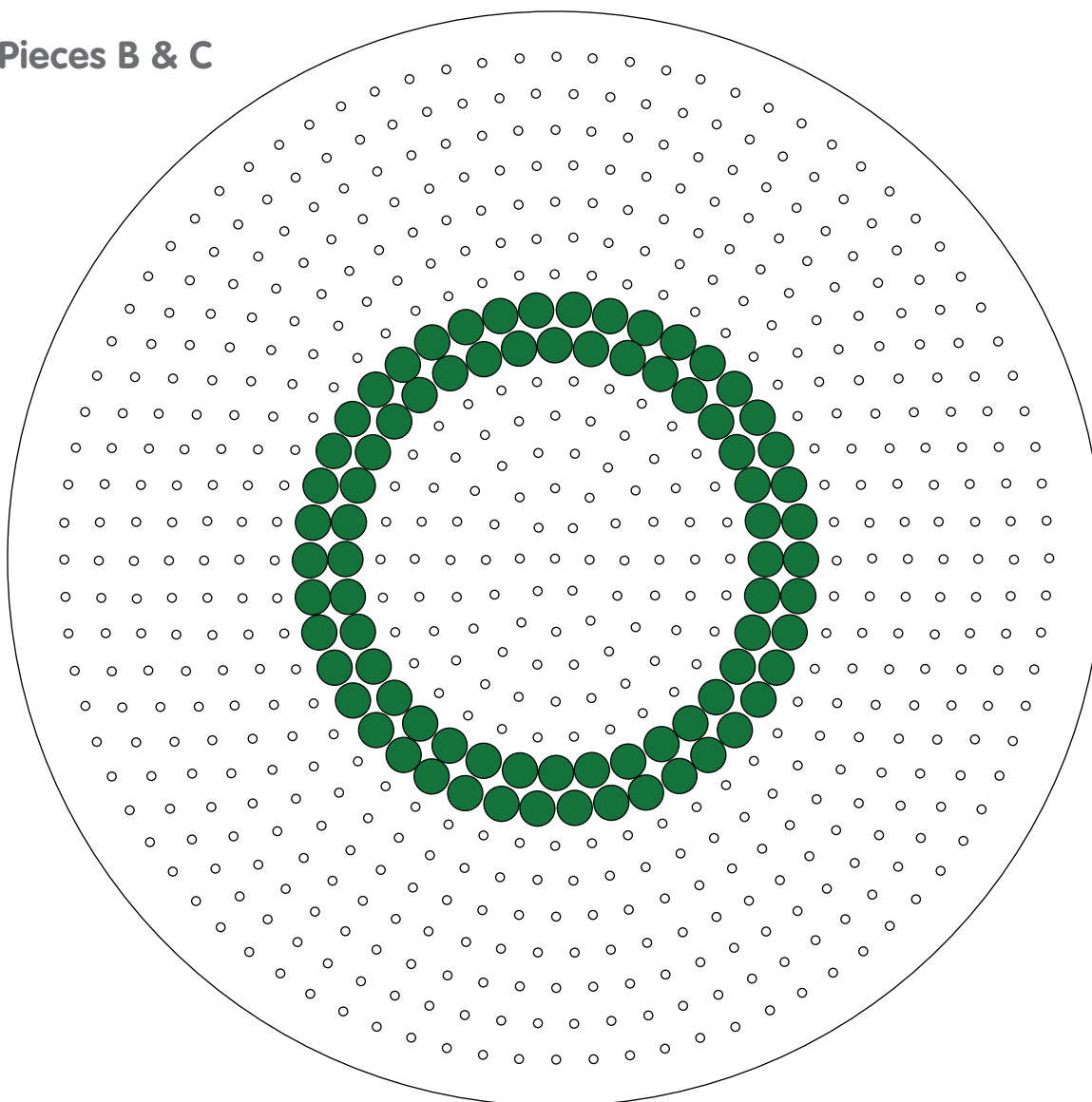
Make 1

Be sure to leave the openings—your flowers will slide into these slots.

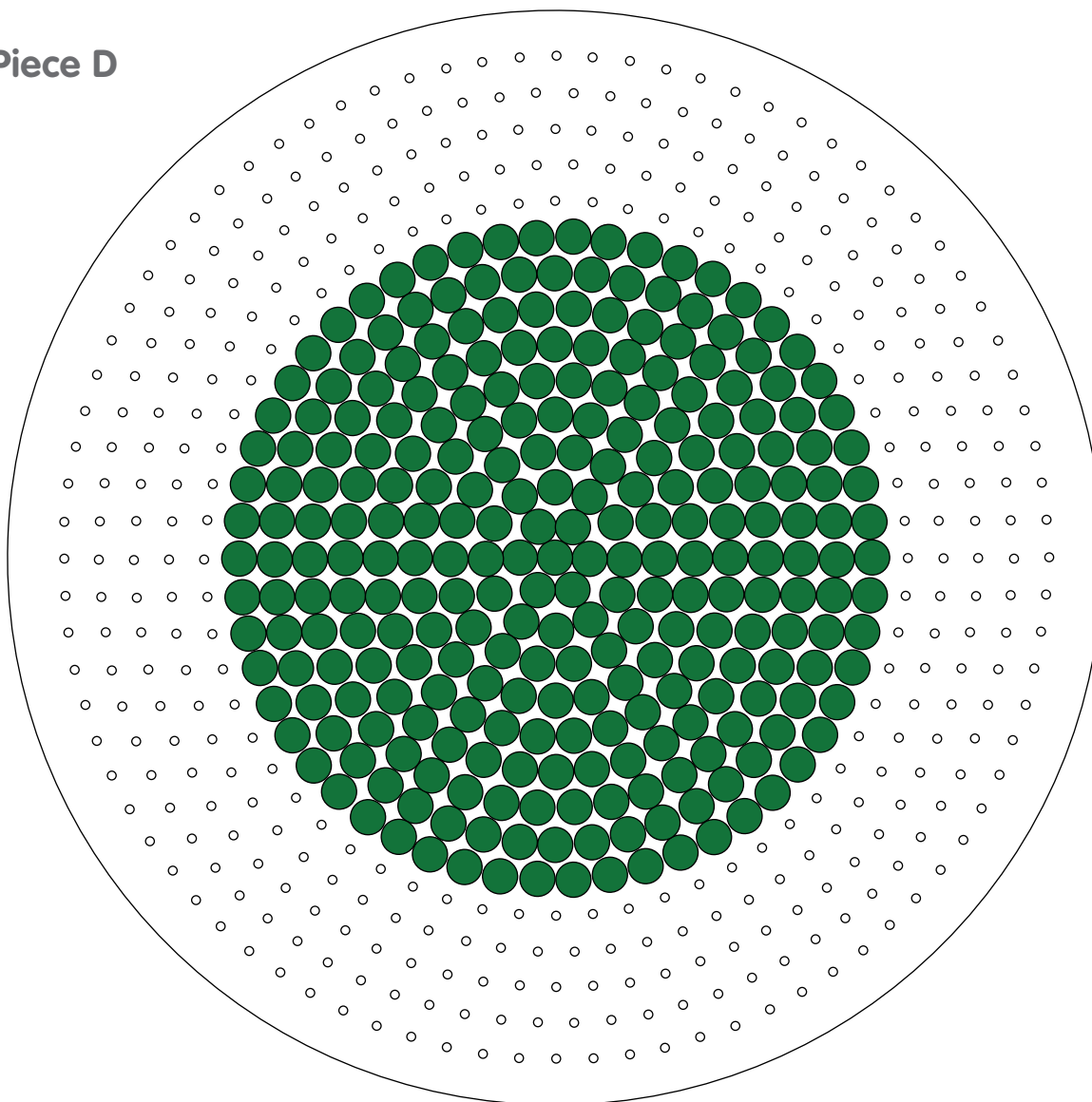

Piece D



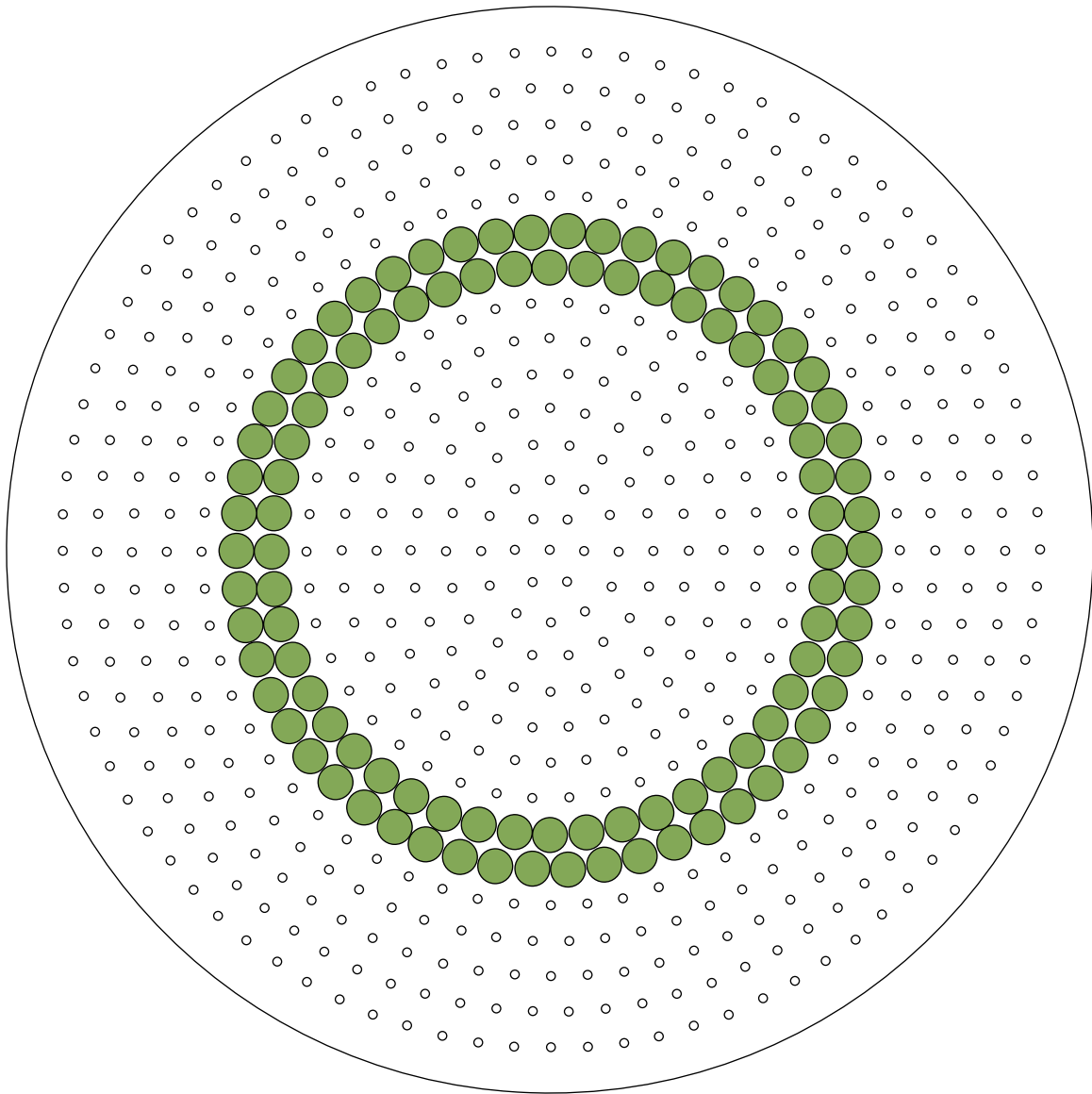

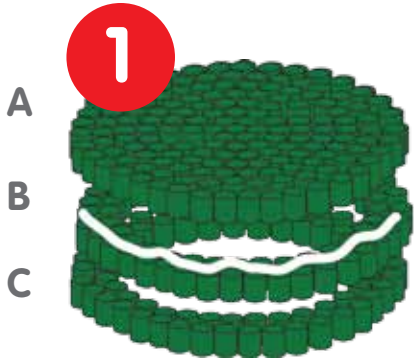
**Bead Color/# Needed:**

-  Green - 102 x 9 = 918
-  Yellow - 102 x 2 = 204
-  Blush - 102 x 2 = 204

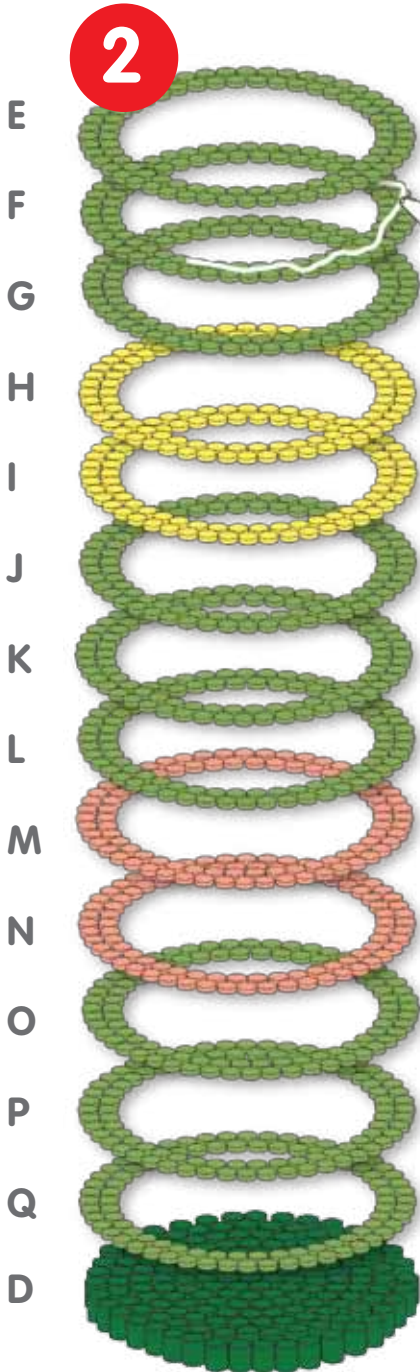
Using the same pattern, make:

- **9 Green** Pieces E, F, G, J, K, L, O, P, Q
- **2 Yellow** Pieces H, I
- **2 Blush** Pieces M, N

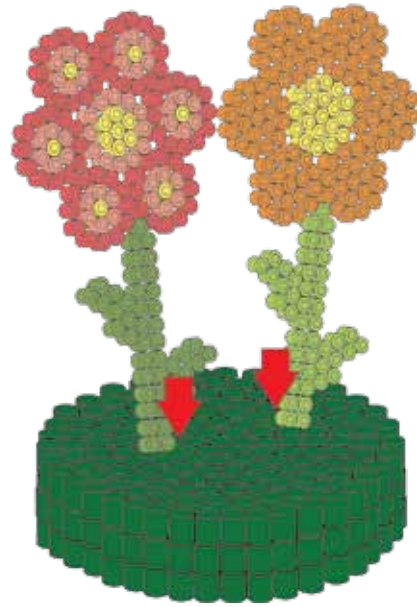
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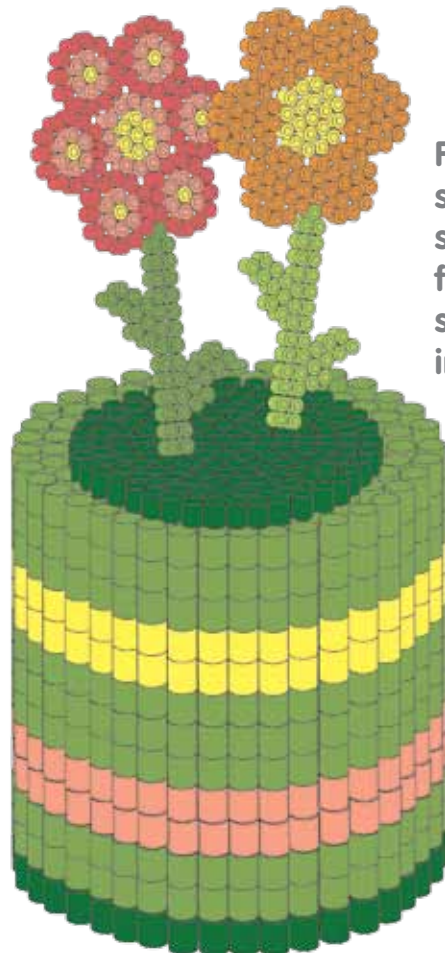
Stack then glue together the first three pieces you made in the order shown.



Stack then glue together all the pieces you made from the pattern on page 5, in the order shown. Add piece D at the bottom.



Place the flower stems into the slots of piece A.



Fit the assembled section from step 3 inside the flower pot from step 2. Push it inside until just the one or two rows of dark green beads shows at the top.
