



YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboards:

- Small circle
- Small square
- Flower

Other:

- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Photos
- Pencil
- Foam adhesive

Bead Colors:

- Black - 60
- ◐ Zebra Stripe - 96
- White - 16
- Pink - 76
- ◐ Pink Candy Stripe - 16

Instructions

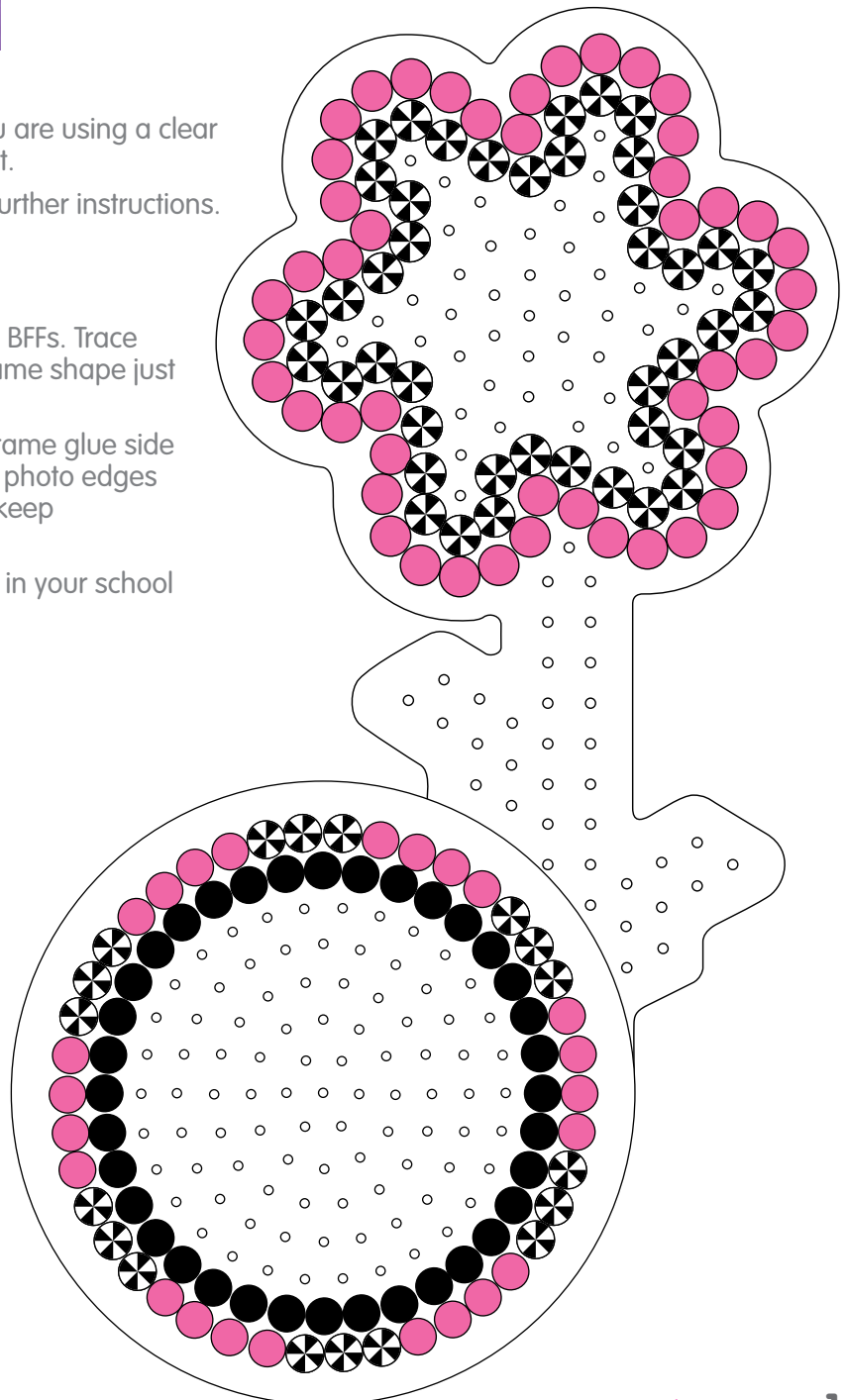
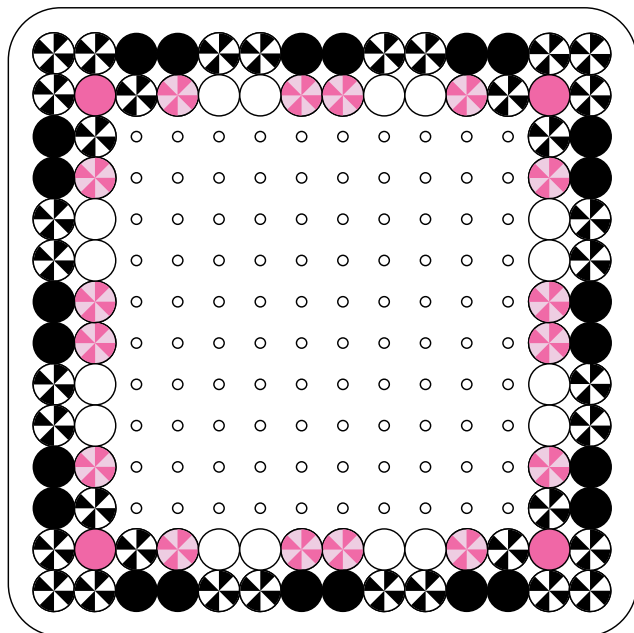
1. Place your beads on the pegboards as shown. If you are using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 2 for further instructions.

ASSEMBLY

Place the frame over your chosen photo of one of your BFFs. Trace the outside of the frame onto the photo. Cut out the frame shape just inside the traced line.

Rub the glue stick over the back of the frame. Set the frame glue side down on the photo. Turn the frame over and press the photo edges on the frame with your fingers. Place under a book to keep everything flat until the glue is dry.

Apply foam adhesive to the back of the frame. Display in your school locker, on the fridge, anywhere you like!



Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely.

Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required. DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make any assembly you do with your project more challenging.
