

Mini Beads Summer Earrings



YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboard:

Mini Beads pegboard

Other:

Mini Beads tweezers
Iron and ironing paper
Six earring hooks
Six 1/4" jump rings
Sewing thread
Fine sewing needle
Small pliers
Glue

Bead Colors:

-  Bubblegum - 72
-  Red - 56
-  Orange - 44
-  Yellow - 78
-  Kiwi Lime - 140
-  Light Blue - 22
-  Tan - 54
-  Brown - 8
-  White - 52


Instructions

- Slide the actual-size pattern under your clear pegboard and place your beads as shown.
- An adult should fuse the designs—see below for further instructions.

- Assembly: Flip Flops:** Thread the sewing needle with thread, bring the ends together and make a knot large enough to not pull through the bead hole. Working from back to front, come up through the yellow bead marked on the pattern with a black dot.

Thread 6 yellow beads onto the thread, then go down through the open hole at the top of the flip flop. Come up through the green bead marked on the pattern with a black dot. Thread 6 yellow beads onto the thread, then go back down through the bead just below the open hold. Knot securely. Glue the daisy flower in place. Repeat for the other flip flop.

All Earrings: With a small pliers, open the jump ring just enough to attach to the open hole of the earring. Slide on an earring hook, then close the jump ring.



Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



- Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
- Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
- Remove the paper and bead design from the pegboard. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely.

Beads need heat for about 10 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required.
