

NOTE: You will need 2 bags each of black and arey beads to create the scene as shown.

Instructions

- 1. Use the large square, large hexagon, large girl, and large boy pegboards for your project. If you're using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it. Place all the beads for the design.
- 2. For the speakers, you will assemble TWO large square pegboards as shown with the patterns. Cut out the individual halves of the chart and tape them together so that you can see the whole design at once.
- 3. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center.
- 4. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #3. Your pegboards and ironing paper are reusable.




Assemble two square pegboards vertically as shown at left. The upper part of the pattern is below, and the lower part of the pattern is on the next page.
