



YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboards:

- 2 Large squares
- Small star

Other:

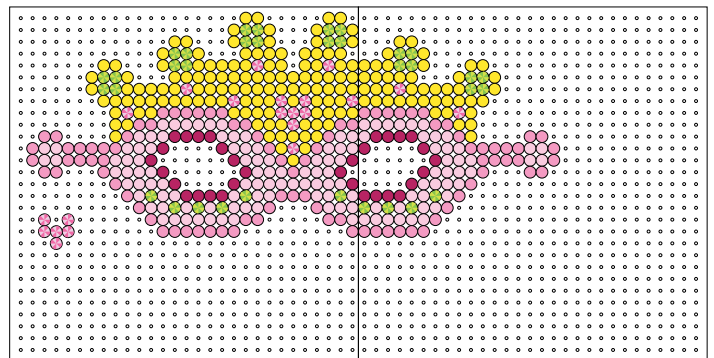
- Scissors
- Clear tape
- Self-adhesive magenta gems: hearts, ovals, round
- Assorted ribbons
- Dowel: 3/16" diameter, 12"
- Craft paint: yellow
- Foam brush
- Quick-drying adhesive

Bead Colors:

- Light Pink - 127
- Bubblegum - 92
- Raspberry - 80
- Yellow - 231
- Pink Candy Stripe - 88
- Prickly Pear Pearl Stripe - 34

Instructions

1. Assemble the two square pegboards as shown below. Cut the patterns out and tape together in the same way. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size patterns underneath them. Place your beads on the pegboards as shown.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see bottom for further instructions. NOTE: For this project, fuse ONLY the back side of the mask—fuse it securely but not flattened (bead holes should still be open). This will enable the mask to curve around the face more easily when worn.
3. **Assembly:** Glue the small heart piece to the center front of the crown over the existing heart shape.
4. Paint the dowel for the wand and let dry. When dry, glue the star to the end of the dowel. Tie varying lengths of ribbons to the top of the wand's handle.



5. Adhere gems to the top of the crown and the wand as shown. Tie varying lengths of ribbons to each side of the crown. Make sure one pair of ribbons is long enough to tie the mask on for wearing.

Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will be securely fused to each other and will still have an open center.
3. Let the design cool.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required. DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make the assembly you do with your project more challenging.
