



Instructions


- 1. Download all the Purse Templates each template is marked A though E. You will need to know the letter of each panel when interlocking them together.
- 2. Using large interlocking square pegboards complete each panel for the purse.
- 3. Cover each project with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Do NOT over iron the beads; it will make it difficult to interlock them together.
- 4. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #3.
- 5. When all the pieces of your purse are completed, assemble the sides and bottom of the purse following the diagram shown here.



6. Interlock parts F and G to form the lid of the purse. Using lacing or thread, tie the bottom of segment F to the top of the back panel, segment C.




7. To make the purse strap, weave clear lacing through beads. This illustration is expanded and lacing is red and blue to more easily show the lacing pattern used. Be sure to tie your string tightly. Leave extra lacing at the strap ends to attach them to the hand bag. Make the strap as long as you like.



8. Use the excess lacing from the purse strap and tie it to the sides of segments D and B as shown here.
