YOU WILL NEED: Pegboards: 2 large squares

Other:

Scissors Clear tape Ironing paper Iron Tweezers 3 Red adhesive gems Thread for hanging

Bead Colors:

Prickly Pear - 6
Purple - 90
Dark Grey - 139
Black - 238

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
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Instructions

- 1. Assemble 2 large square pegboards as shown above. Cut out and tape together the pattern halves, then place your beads on the pegboards as shown. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size pattern underneath them.
- 2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 2 for further instructions.
- Thread a hanger through the bat's head. Add red adhesive gems for the eyes and mouth.

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Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.

2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.

3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. If you wish to add a little curve to the wings, curve them around a glass or can while still warm and hold in place with rubber bands until completely cool.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required.
